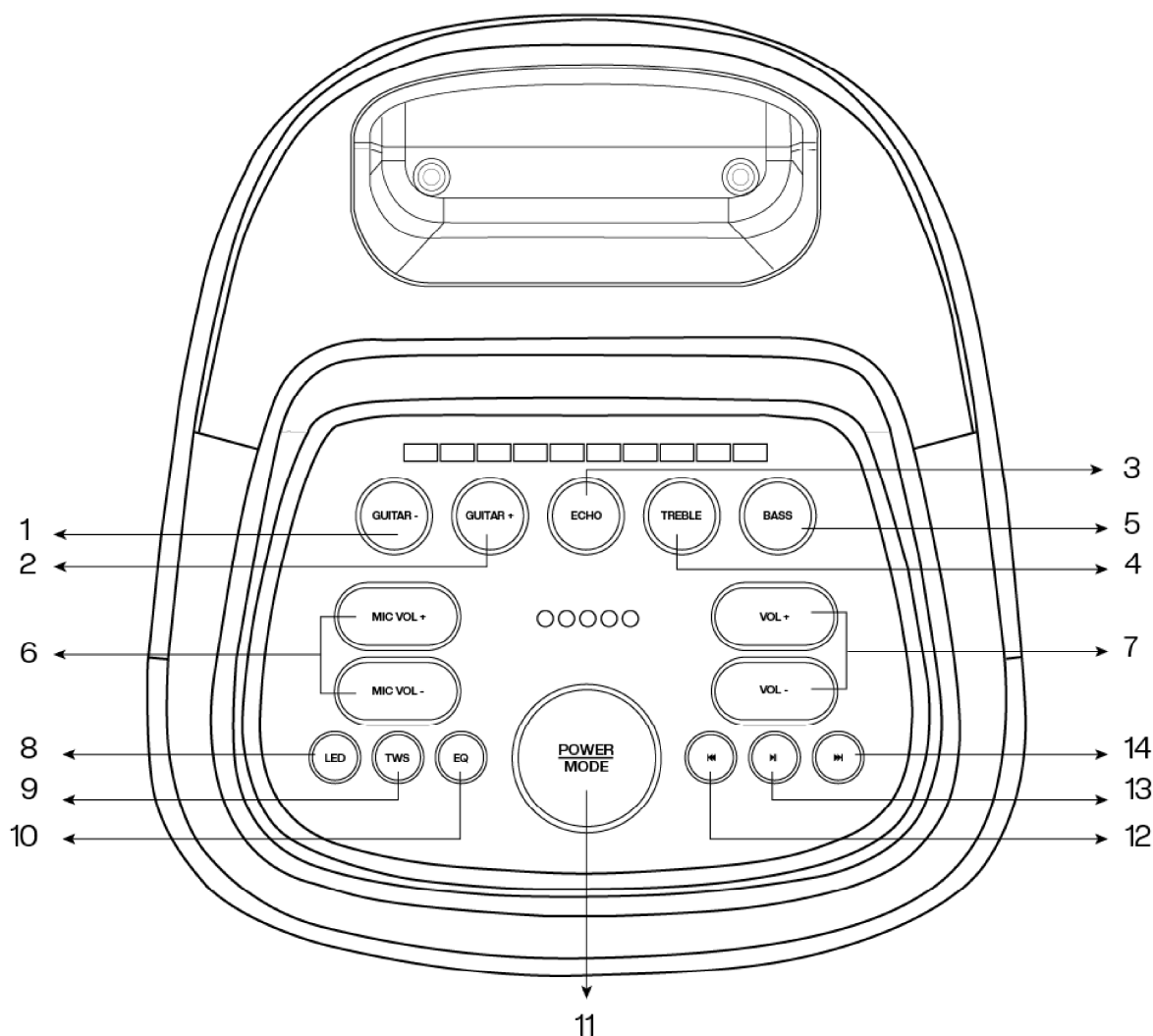
Safety information

1. This product is not a toy. Keep it out of reach of children.
2. Warning: This product includes lithium polymer batteries.
3. Keep product out of the reach of children and pets to avoid chewing and swallowing.
4. Product operating and storage temperature is from 0 degree Celsius to 40 degree Celsius. Under and over this temperature might affect the function.
5. Never open the product. Touching the inside electrics can cause electric shock. Repairs or service should only be performed by qualified personnel.
6. Do not expose to heat, water, moisture, direct sunlight!
7. Please protect your ears against loud volume. Loud volume can damage your ears and risk in hearing loss.
8. Bluetooth wireless technology operates within a range of about 10 m (30 feet). The maximum communication distance may vary depending on the presence of obstacles (people, metal objects, walls, etc.) or the electromagnetic environment.
9. Microwaves emitting from a Bluetooth device may affect the operation of electronic medical devices.
10. The unit is not waterproof. If water or foreign objects enter the unit, it may result in fire or electric shock. If water or a foreign object enters the unit, stop use immediately.
11. Only charge with supplied charging cable.
12. Do not use non original accessories together with the product as this can make the product functionality abnormal.

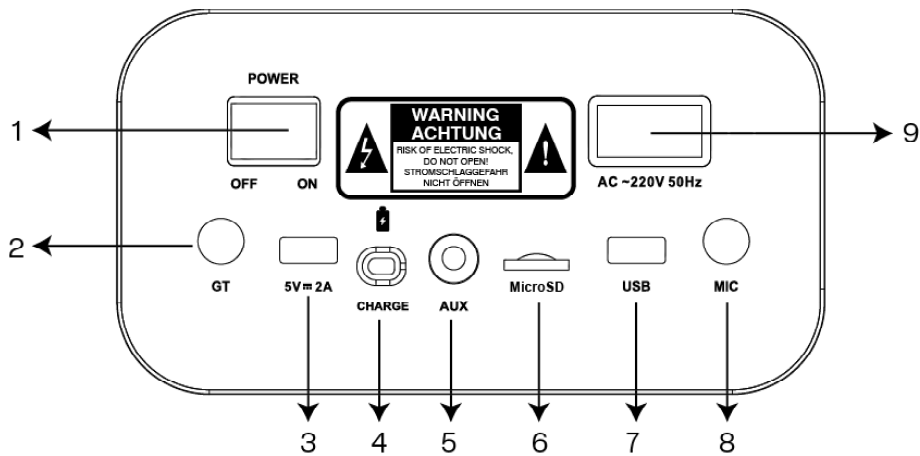

Control Panel:

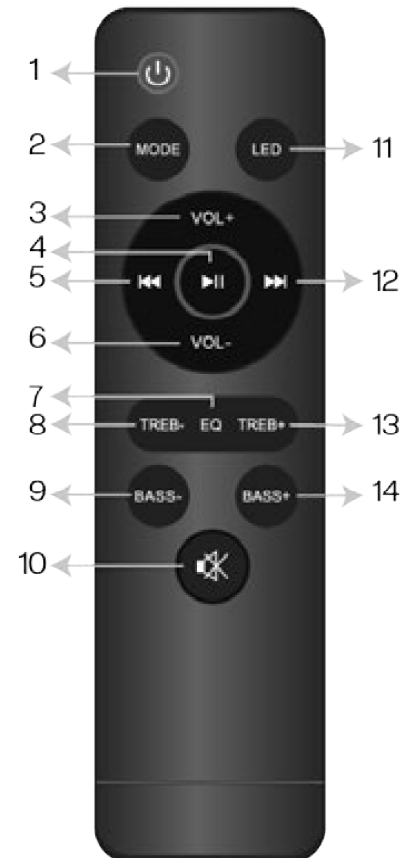
1. GUITAR -: Decrease the volume of guitar.
2. GUITAR +: Increase the volume of guitar.
3. ECHO: Adjust the echo of microphone.
4. TREBLE: Adjust the treble of the speaker
5. BASS: Adjust the bass of the speaker.
6. MIC VOL-/MIC VOL+: Adjust the volume of microphone.
7. VOL-/VOL+: Adjust the volume of the speaker.
8. LED: Change the led light mode.
9. TWS: Connect two speakers with TWS.
10. EQ: Adjust the EQ.
11. POWER/MODE: Press and hold to power on/off the speaker. Short press to change the modes.
12. ⏮ : Previous song.
13. ⏸ : Short press to play/pause music.
14. ⏭ :Next song.



1. Hard switch power on/off.
2. Guitar input.
3. Charging for mobile phone.
4. Charging LED light: The indicator light remains red during charging and turns blue when fully charged.
5. Aux Input.
6. Micro SD card slot.
7. USB input.
8. Microphone input.
9. AC Jack: Charging port.

Remote control:

1. On/Off Switch.
2. MODE: Press to switch between operating modes: BT mode, Micro SD card mode, U disk mode, AUX mode.
3. VOL+: To increase volume.
4. **▶||**: Short press to play/pause music.
5. **◀◀**: To select the previous song from USB /Micro SD/ BT.
6. VOL-: To reduce volume.
7. EQ: To set equalizer variants.
8. TREBLE -: To reduce the treble.
9. BASS -: To reduce the bass.
10. MUTE: To mute.
11. LED: To change the LED mode.
12. **▶▶**: To select the next song from USB/Micro SD/ BT.
13. TREBLE +: To increase the treble.
14. BASS +: To increase the BASS.



FUNCTION DESCRIPTION

1. Charge the speaker

To charge the speaker's built-in battery, connect AC cable to the charging port. The battery charging LED will be red, and will turn to blue when fully charged.

2. Bluetooth function

- Power on the product then press MODE button to enter BT mode.
- Put your mobile device (cell phones, computers, etc.) into BT pairing mode, search for BT devices, and select the item name BPS-370 when it appears.
- After the device has been paired successfully for the first time, it will connect automatically in around 10 seconds to the device last connected when next time use. (Note: The product can connect to only one Bluetooth device at a time.)

Bluetooth Re-connection Function:

- Press and hold ►|| to disconnect the Bluetooth connection between the mobile device (cell phones, computers, etc.) and the speaker.
- Press and hold ►|| again to reconnect the Bluetooth connection between the mobile device and the speaker. For detailed Bluetooth connection instructions, please refer to the above "Bluetooth function".

3.TWS Function

Power on two speakers and enter Bluetooth mode.

Turn off the Bluetooth function on your phone or other Bluetooth device. press the TWS button of either speaker, A voice prompt will then be heard to signify that the two speakers have connected via Bluetooth.

Turn on Bluetooth on the mobile phone and search for “BPS-370” and connect.

A voice prompt will then be heard signifying that the mobile has connected to the speakers. You can now enjoy music from the two speakers.

4. USB mode

1. Insert a USB device into the speaker's USB port.
2. Or press MODE to switch to USB mode.
3. Press the ►|| button to play or pause the music.

5. Auxiliary input mode

1. Connect a 3.5 mm audio cable to the unit's auxiliary input.
2. Press MODE to switch to auxiliary input mode.
3. Use the controls of the connected device to select and play the audio.

6. Micro SD card mode

1. Insert an SD card, SD card mode will start automatically.
2. Or press MODE to switch to Micro SD card mode.
3. Press the ►|| button to play or pause the music.
